(*) 9	Mentor Program	Every Monday afternoon at 2:00 the Operations Manager sits down with the News Director to review and evaluate the week in news and plan the next week.
5	High School Internship	Bellefontaine High School Senior Ian Beale shadowed the Newsroom for six weeks in the fall of 2008 from 1-3pm four days a week.
5	College Internship	Malone College student Matt Strayer interned during the summer (May-June 2008) in the news dept. Left in June after receiving a job offer.
8	International Broadcasters Idea Bank for News & Programming	Operations Manager Chad Wilkinson and News Director Bill Tipple attended a two-day seminar in St. Louis to exchange ideas on News & Programming small market radio stations. (January 2009)
5	WPKO & WBLL Sportscasters Camp	WPKO & WBLL conducted a one week Sportscasters camp for kids ages 12-18. This camp ran for one week (June 23 rd -June27) at the Hilliker YMCA. Campers learned how to do play-by-play, interview, research, radio advertising, skills of being on the radio and spoke with professionals in the field. Guest speakers included Tom Hamilton of the Cleveland Indians, Paul Keels of the Ohio State Buckeyes and George

		Mathews of the Columbus Blue Jackets. Campers also called a live baseball game on the radio on 1390 WBLL.
10	Guest Speaker	In December 2008 Operations Manager Chad Wilkinson spoke with four different Jr. High classes at West Liberty-Salem. Each class was educated on the radio business and asked questions pertaining to a job in radio.

 For “Activity Classification” use number “1” through “16” in accordance with the following:

1. Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in making hiring decisions.
2. Hosting of at least one job fair.
3. Co-sponsoring of at least one job fair with organizations in the business and professional community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

6. Participation in job banks, Internet programs and other programs designed to promote outreach generally (i.e., outreach that is not primarily directed to providing notification of specific job vacancies);
7. Participation in scholarship programs designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting;
8. Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions;
9. Establishment of a mentoring program for station personnel;
10. Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting;
11. Sponsorship of at least two events in the community designed to inform and educate members of the public about employment opportunities in broadcasting;
12. Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation by women and minorities;
13. Provision of assistance to unaffiliated non-profit entities in the maintenance of websites that provide counseling on the process of searching for broadcast employment and/or other career development assistance pertinent to broadcasting;
14. Provision of training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination.
15. Provision of training to personnel of unaffiliated non-profit organizations interested in broadcast employment opportunities that would enable them to better refer job candidates for broadcast positions;
16. Participation in other activities designed by the station reasonably calculated to further the goal of disseminating information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities.
